Enrollment and Registration Information

*All registering students must have legal parent/guardian present to enroll.

Students Coming from Within Washoe County School District:

- Please log in to your Infinite Campus Parent Portal and make sure you have completed the online registration for the upcoming school year.
- If your student is an incoming freshman, please be sure to check Infinite Campus to make sure they haven't already been registered.
- If you have recently moved and are now zoned for Reed High School, you will need to withdraw your student from their current school and all you need to bring is a valid ID and current proof of residence. Parent/Guardian driver's licenses are not accepted as a valid proof of residence.

Students Enrolling Who Have Never Attended School in the Washoe County School District:

- All incoming students need to complete the Online Registration Process. Please go to <u>www.washoeschools.net</u> and hover over "Schools" at the top of the page. Scroll down and click on "Register for School". In the next screen you will need to click on "Kindergarten and new to WCSD Online Registration." Please note that you will need a valid and accessible email address to complete the registration.
- After the registration is complete, you will need to have the following items ready to bring in with you.
 - 1. **Birth Certificate-** Must be the original document, no copies.
 - 2. **Immunizations Records** Students will not be registered unless this has been provided and all immunizations are up to date.
 - 3. **Proof of Residence-** Must be a current utility bill with legal guardian's name and address clearly displayed. Driver's licenses will not suffice as proof.
 - 4. **If your student is enrolling as a 9th grader** after the start of the school year, we will need a current report card or schedule.
 - 5. **If your student is enrolling as a 10th, 11th, or 12th grader** we will need an **unofficial transcript** from their most recent school. If starting after the start of the school year, we ask that you also bring a current class schedule.
