Speech-to-Text – Requires solitary placement and signed confidentiality form.	
Student uses their own assistive technology devices to produce written responses. Test administrators must transcribe student responses into the online test delivery system.	
Student uses the embedded speech-to-text accommodation with vendor-designated settings for operating system and test delivery system.	
Text-to-Speech for online testing – Requires headphones OR solitary placement and signed confidentiality form.	
Embedded for ELA reading passages – Only for GRADES 6-8 and blind students at all grades who have not acquired adequate Braille skills.
