

SUBJECT: Practice for Online Testing; Practice Using Embedded Accessibility Supports

DRC INSIGHT **Online Tools Training/OTTs** provide a set of sample test questions to introduce students and staff to the tools available during testing and prepare them for the spring Science and Summative Smarter Balanced (ELA, Math) assessments.

>> Practice with the Online Tools Training/OTT

- The OTTs allow students to try the features of the testing software before the live test.
- The OTTs are not indicative of test content or intended to serve as test practice in grade level content.
- The OTTs are meant to familiarize students with online tools and are not scored.
- The OTTs model the delivery format of different designated support selections.

>> Practice Testing with Embedded Accessibility Supports

Students requiring selected accessibility supports (designated supports, accommodations) for testing, and educators assigning these supports, should be familiar and have experience with the different test delivery formats available. Students who will test with embedded TTS or language translation support should use the matching OTT to experience their selected test version in advance of the live test.

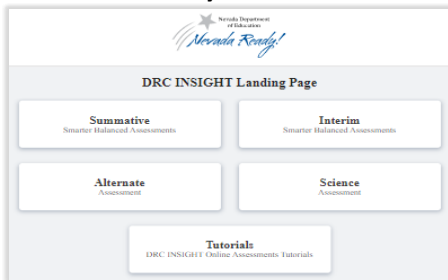
>> Test Delivery Format Selected in Advance

The test delivery format to be used by a student must be identified in advance by the school test coordinator in accordance with a student's accessibility supports plan for instruction and assessments. Contact Assessment Support to apply selected test version in the DRC INSIGHT portal before printing student test tickets.

IMPORTANT:

- Online test delivery formats are unique to the support selected and cannot be combined with other embedded supports and accommodations. Embedded designated supports and accommodations may differ by content area.
- OTT practice is not available for VSL (video sign language), CC (closed captioning with VSL), Braille (print format), or STT Integrated (speech to text integrated using special DRC INSIGHT Permissive Mode).

Launch the OTT through the DRC INSIGHT secure browser installed on student testing devices.



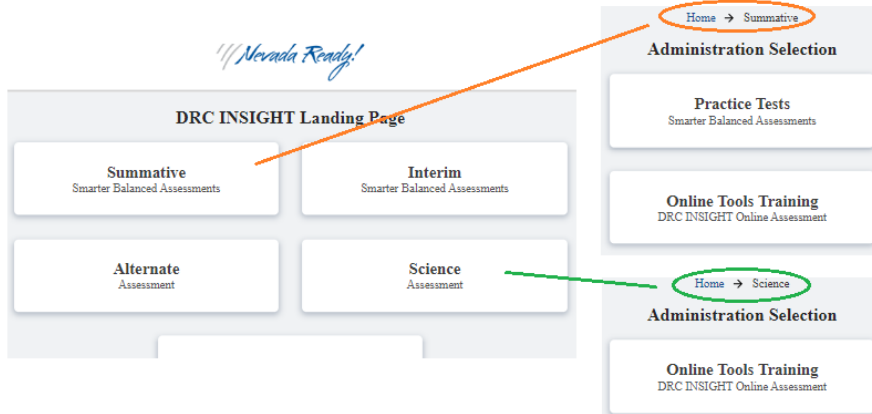

SCIENCE

Grade 5, Grade 8, High School

- Science (regular testing conditions; no added supports)
- TTS Science (designated support, TTS/text-to-speech)
- Dual Language (Stack Spanish) Science (Spanish & English with Spanish audio)
- Spanish Glossing Science (glossing in Cantonese and Tagalog available for live test only)

SUMMATIVE MATHEMATICS

Grade 3-5, Grades 6-8

- Grades 3-5 Mathematics (regular testing conditions; no added supports)
- Grades 3-5 Mathematics (designated support, TTS/text-to-speech)
- Grades 3-5 Dual Language (Stack Spanish) Mathematics (Spanish & English with Spanish audio)
- Grades 3-5 Spanish Glossing Mathematics (glossing in Cantonese and Tagalog available for live test only)
- Grades 6-8 Mathematics (designated support, TTS/text-to-speech)
- Grades 6-8 Mathematics (regular testing conditions; no added supports)
- Grades 6-8 Dual Language (Stack Spanish) Mathematics (Spanish & English with Spanish audio)
- Grades 6-8 Spanish Glossing Mathematics (glossing in Cantonese and Tagalog available for live test only)

SUMMATIVE ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Grades 3-5, Grades 6-8

- Grades 3-5 English Language Arts (regular testing conditions; no added supports)
- Grades 3-5 TTS English Language Arts (designated support, TTS/text-to-speech without passages)
- Grades 6-8 English Language Arts (regular testing conditions; no added supports)
- Grades 3-5* TTS English Language Arts (designated support, TTS/text-to-speech without passages)
- Grades 6-8 TTS English Language Arts (accommodation, TTS WITH PASSAGES*)

**Note: Students in grades 6-8 using TTS designated support should practice with the Grades 3-5 TTS version which will not include TTS for passages. The OTT Grades 3-5 TTS demonstrates the designated support version without passages. The OTT Grades 6-8 TTS demonstrates the accommodation version with TTS for reading passages.*
