- The Board of Trustees approved the minutes of the March 14, 2023 Regular Meetings of the Board of Trustee (Agenda Item 2.02).
- The Board of Trustees approved the minutes of the April 11, 2023 Work Session of the Board of Trustees (Agenda Item 2.03).

- The Board of Trustees approved the Memorandum of Understanding between the Washoe County School District and Toll North Reno LLC to facilitate the donation of a +/-10.55 acre parcel of land for a future elementary school within the planned Quilici subdivision located in Verdi, Nevada (Agenda Item 2.07).
