



### What is a Signature Academy?

- A Signature Academy is a specialized high school program that focuses on a career path and/or area of study.
- Signature Academies are offered at most high schools in WCSD.
- Students in 8<sup>th</sup> grade can submit a request to attend a Signature Academy at any high school in the District based on their personal interests.

- Why should students consider a Signature Academy?
  - These programs provide students the opportunity to:
    - Explore specific career paths
    - Develop leadership and workforce readiness skills
    - Connect with local businesses and organizations
    - Earn college credit and/or job certifications
    - Apply hands-on learning in areas such as agriculture, business, engineering, human and social services, medicine, skilled trades and technology
  - Signature Academies are a great way to study something that interests you while preparing you for life after high school!





### • Who can participate in a Signature Academy?

- All interested 8<sup>th</sup> graders
- \*It is recommended that students demonstrate:
  - 2.0 overall GPA
  - Grade-level performance on standardized tests (i.e. SBAC, MAPS)
  - History of generally acceptable attendance and behavior

\*It is important to note that no student will be denied because of these considerations, it is only recommended because of the levels of academics required to be successful in many of the Signature Academy programs.

# How does transportation to a Signature Academy work?

- If you are placed as a student in a
   Signature Academy, you will have
   to provide your own
   transportation, <u>except</u> for AACT,
   Wooster, or your zoned high school
- AACT and Wooster provide busing to students who need it





### How do sports work at a Signature Academy?

- Students who attend AACT can still participate in sports at their zoned high school.
- A student attending any other Signature Academy is eligible
- to participate in sports at that school only.
