

### Student Success Goal

A PRIORITY GOAL of Hunter Lake is to raise the number of students in the Hispanic/EL Population and students with an IEP who are proficient as measured by the SBAC (Level 3 or 4 proficiency) by at least 3 percentage points in both math and ELA.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Utilizing GLAD strategies
2. Specially targeted ELs and IEP students who will receive targeted Tier 3 instruction in small groups and iReady-leveled instruction in both math and reading in after-school tutoring.
