
Reminders from Athletic Secretary Tina Rooker

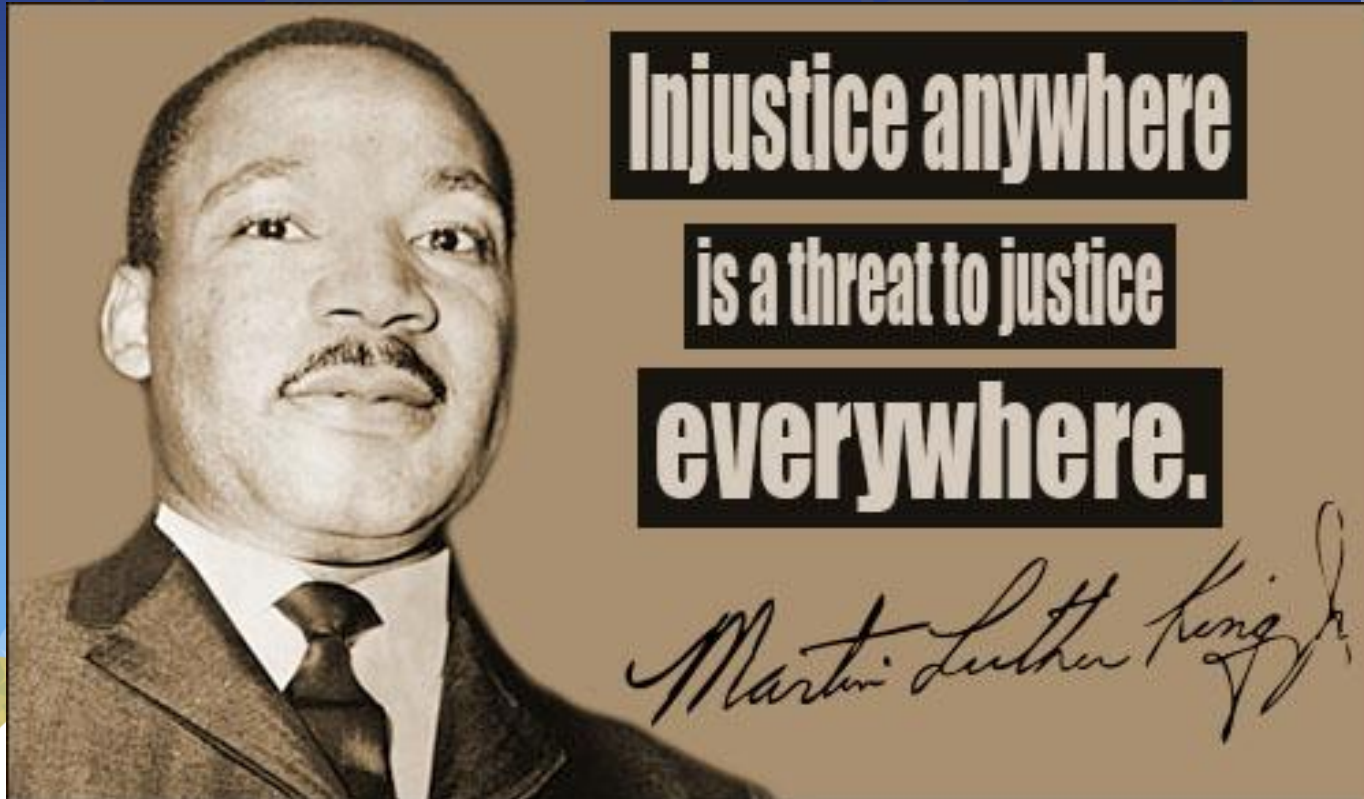
