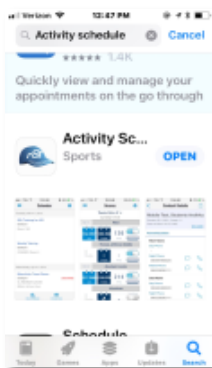

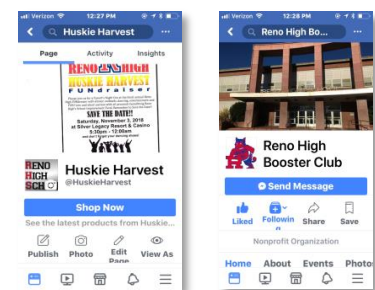

- FRESHMAN YEAR: *Interest Profiler* (introduces the student to a variety of careers that align with their interests, allowing them to research more about specific careers including wages and necessary education), setting up an account.
- SOPHOMORE YEAR: *Budget Your Life* - student will get a sense of what it will cost them to live the lifestyle that they want vs. the salaries of careers that they identify with in the Interest Profiler. They have the option to continue with other assessments and can research the cost of colleges.
- JUNIOR YEAR: students participate in the *Junior Interview Project*, a collaboration between students, RHS teachers, and community volunteers. The students develop a resume in The Cube (Career Center), and then participate in a 20-minute mock-interview. We need VOLUNTEERS!
- SENIOR YEAR: continue to utilize *Dream IT Do It* to do further assessments, research colleges/trade schools that support their career interest, research jobs and develop a plan for after they graduate!
