CLASS DESCRIPTION

Freshman Seminar is a course designed to promote a successful transition between middle school and high school. The course provides students with opportunities for academic enrichment, test taking skills, and note taking skills; it improves organizational skills, and communication skills. Teachers mentor and track student progress during the course of the semester. In addition, students have class time to work on assignments from other courses.

CLASS POLICIES & EXPECTATIONS

If you follow the expectations and share in the vision of this classroom along with the requirements outlined below we'll have a positive, productive experience this year.

1. **Be a Grizzly!** Students will follow the policies of Galena High School as explained in the Galena Planner. No food or drinks in the classroom – only water. GRADES

- Each class period is worth 10 points. Students earn full points for coming prepared to class, for completing the daily lessons and bell ringers, and for staying on task. Students may work on acceptable assignments which include but are not limited to homework, reading <u>appropriate</u> materials, studying for a test or quiz, making up missed quizzes/tests, library time and other teacher-approved activities.
- Grade Checks for ALL classes will be sent home twice per quarter for parents to review and sign.
- Grade breakdown: Semester Final Exam 20%; Daily Classwork 60%; Grade Checks 20%.
