When asked how I could better help my child learn the math she needed to know, I was told by a acher "come to class". Obviously, my child could not come to class at the time. I am a medical school professor. If the hools had helped provide any useful resources for me to assist my kids at home I would have done so. One of my childre 10 is gifted/talented but chronically ill, went from straight Ds/Fs in the rigid public school system to almost straight As in a arter that was more flexible in dealing with her illness. Your policies for dealing with kids who are in the foster system or ve physical or psychiatric illness do not work. They set the kids up to fail, with poor access to home study materials, istence timely turning in of countless but often meaningless assignments (like signed agendas) in order to pass, and lexibility with children who have serious medical or psychosocial issues interfering with their ability to function in a "norma hool environment. I have 5 kids, 4 with special needs of some kind. My experience is that they were thriving in charter hools and suffering in public schools, with the exception of Damonte Ranch.
