Grading Procedures

*Jazz Band grade band grades will be determined using the assessment areas below.

ASSESSMENTS (33% of overall grade)

We will have several playing tests during the year to check the progress of each student. Tests will be based on weekly practice logs. You will always be given ample notification and will only be tested on concepts that have been covered in class. If you are practicing regularly, you will not have a problem with the playing tests. We will also have several written tests during the year.

PRACTICE (22% of overall grade)

Home practice is a critical element of playing an instrument. Students will complete weekly practice goals and then submit a practice log (can be found both online and in class). 30 completed goals are considered a 100% and students may complete up to 42 goals for extra credit. Students should set aside about 120 minutes a week for practice and are encouraged to divide this time up evenly throughout the week.

PARTICIPATION (30% of overall grade)

Your participation is graded according to your preparedness and active participation in class. You may receive up to 20 points per class session. To be considered prepared for band; you need to bring the following items to every band class:

- Instrument: 10 points
- Music, Standard of Excellence, Jazz Ensemble Method: 5 points
- Instrument accessories (reeds, oil, etc.): 2 points
- Pencil: 3 points

Participation points will also be subtracted if you are off task and/or disrupting the class.

CONCERT ATTENDANCE (15% of overall grade)

We will have several concerts during the year. Concert participation is MANDATORY and a large part of your grade. Absences are excused at the director's discretion. If you must miss a concert, please email Mr. Scarbrough at least two weeks before, or within 24 hours after the concert. PLEASE NOTE: Non-school related sports or team practices, games, or competitions DO NOT qualify as an excused absence. An alternate assignment will be given for excused absences. If you can avoid scheduling elective surgeries/procedures before concerts (especially dental), please do! See the band calendar and the band webpage so you can ensure your attendance at all concerts this year.

CLASSROOM RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

As with any other classroom, certain rules and expectations are placed upon all students. The music rooms rules are: 1) No talking while the teacher(s) is working with the class. 2) No food, gum, candy, or flavored drinks. Water is okay. 3) Only handle your personal belongings. 4) Leave the room in better condition than you found it – chairs and stands away, instruments and music where they belong, etc.

The expectations are: 1) Make good choices – If you must ask if it's okay to do something, it probably isn't. 2) Use appropriate language both musically and socially. 3) Show respect to everyone. 4) Involve yourself (we only succeed if EVERYONE puts forth 100%). 5) Care for our room and instruments. Should you choose not to follow or respect these rules and expectations, disciplinary action will be taken.

Students who cannot follow the rules and expectations will begin the discipline plan explained on the next page.

DISCIPLINE PLAN

I will use a progressive discipline plan should students choose not to follow the rules and expectations. If student repeats these behaviors regularly, he or she will be removed from band for the remainder of the year.

- 1- Verbal correction and instructions for solution
- 2- "Time out" from rehearsal for a short time, parental notification and write up in IC
- 3- Removal from rehearsal for remainder of class, parent notification, write up in IC
- 4- Removal from classroom, parent notification, IC write up, and administration involvement.

CITIZENSHIP (Weekly grades will be given for behavior and work ethic)

My policy for citizenship is basic manners, which I hope you have acquired before this class:

- Be respectful to teacher, instruments, and fellow classmates
- Do not talk or play out of turn
- Enter and leave classroom quietly and orderly



Supplies Needed – Jazz Band

Every student is responsible for providing the following supplies for band class by August 19th,

- 1) Instrument School Rental* or Personal
- 2) Music Folder will be provided at the beginning of the school year
- 3) Music Book: Standard of Excellence, Jazz Ensemble Method for your instrument. All other music will be provided in class
- 4) **Portable Music Stand** (for practice at home)
- 5) **Pencil** (keep a pencil in your instrument case, we will use them daily!)

- Cork Grease

TROMBONE

- Slide Cream/Oil
- Mini water spray bottle

- Valve Oil
- Slide Grease
- Polishing cloth

Bass/Guitar

- patch cord for amplifiers
- anything else you need to play (straps, tuners, extra strings, etc.)

Drums

- 1 pair of Vic Firth 5A drumsticks
- 1 pair of medium hard mallets
- 1 Pair of brushes

Band Performance Uniform

We will wear a unique performance uniform at all concerts. Students out of uniform will be asked to change immediately or be sent home from the performance. The uniform includes:

- BLACK Jazz Performance Polo
- Black Slacks or black calf-length skirt
- Black Shoes/Flats
- Black Socks (if wearing flats, no socks required)

0Band Instrument Rental/Purchase Procedures 2019 - 2020

Rental/Purchase Options:

- Rent from a local music store (or online). Prices: \$20 50 per month. Music stores and locations are available on the Pine Music website.
- Purchase from a local music store or online (do not recommend this option for beginners). If you are going to purchase, Mr. Scarbrough is happy to give input about instrument quality and price.
- School Instrument rentals are available for \$50 for the school year. Limited inventory on popular instruments (trumpets, saxophones, and clarinets). These instruments are on a first come, first serve basis. Drum set instruments cannot be rented out.

Rental Procedures:

- Music Stores: Families review prices from different stores and then go in to rent.
- School-owned instruments: Parents who need a school instrument submit a School Rental Application (attached). Instruments are distributed on first come first serve basis. For all school-owned instruments, Mr. Scarbrough will then send home a rental contract. Students will not receive school instruments until Mr. Scarbrough has received the completed contract and payment. Each instrument has a required \$50 rental fee.

Charms

Pine Middle School Music Department will be utilizing a 3rd Party bookkeeping system called Charms. This allows teachers, students, and parents to keep track of their music account, manage receipts, and assign inventory digitally. Parents may access their student's financial information at any point by following the log-in procedures located on the Pine Music Website. Student information such as Name, Gender, Student ID#, instrument, and contact information (not address) is collected and stored for Director use only. No other personal data will be collected or used. The formal media release is attached below.

Remind

In addition to IC, Mr. Scarbrough will also be using a 3rd Party contact system called Remind. It is a 1-way text-message communication network that allows Mr. S to contact students and parents without exchanging direct phone numbers. Remind collects student/parent cell phone # and/or email, first & last name. See media release below.

Private Lessons

It is <u>strongly recommended</u> that students enroll in private lessons. In a private lesson, your child would meet with a specialist on their instrument on a regular basis. If you have noticed that your child has really taken to their instrument, this would be a great next step. Students enrolled in private lessons will often become the most advanced students in class as well as create collegiate scholarship opportunities. You can contact Mr. Scarbrough for teacher recommendations. When you contact a private teacher, please be prepared to ask them the following questions:

How much they charge for a lesson. (30-minute lessons are good for 6th grade and I recommend 45-60 minute lessons for
7th/8th grade)
What times they have available.
Do they do lessons weekly, bi-monthly, etc. (if money is tight, taking lessons every other week is a good compromise).
Where they teach (at home, at a studio) or if they will travel to your home (this usually costs more).
Their music education/experience. Do they have a music degree? How many years have they been teaching?

When starting a new private teacher, I recommend doing the first few lessons on a trial basis to ensure that the teacher and student are a good match. Also, call a few teachers to get their rates before deciding on one. If you have any questions about this matter, please don't hesitate to contact Mr. Scarbrough either by email or by leaving a message at school.

Adjust your Infinite Campus Message Settings

You can adjust your Infinite Campus Message settings to allow teacher messages to go directly to your email. This is very handy for grade warnings and other important class information for band and all classes. For instructions about how to adjust your settings, visit the band website (www.washoeschools.net/pinemusic) under Announcements. There is a link here that will take you to the instructions.
