Band Grading Procedures

*Band grades will be determined using the grading categories below.

ASSESSMENTS (33% of overall grade)

- Playing tests: these will be done in class weekly. Playing tests may be re-taken for a higher grade until the end of the quarter.
- <u>Pass-off tests</u>: there will be several of these assigned each quarter. The goal of these tests is to pass with 100% accuracy as they will cover the basic building blocks of musicianship. Students may take them as many times as they would like until the end of the quarter and if they are unable to pass with 100%, I will enter the grade they earn on their third attempt.
- Written assessments: these will be given to show knowledge of music reading, symbols, and terms.
- <u>To note for all assessments</u>: You will always be given ample notification and will only be tested on concepts that have been covered in class. If you are practicing regularly, you will not have a problem with any of the tests.

PRACTICE (22% of overall grade)

Home practice is a critical element of playing an instrument! Students will complete weekly practice assignments and then submit electronically at the end of each week (via the band website under the 'Practice Logs' page). Each assignment will have a set amount of goals to complete, and students may complete more than the required amount to earn extra credit. Students should set aside about 40 minutes/week for practice and are encouraged to divide this time up evenly throughout the week (four 10-minute practices would be perfect). This means they will need to take their instrument home regularly (they may also practice in the band room after school or at lunch if arranged ahead of time). Late work is graded at 80% after the due date and will NOT be accepted after a week from the due date.

CLASS PERFORMANCE (30% of overall grade)

Your performance is graded according to your preparedness and active performance in class. You may receive up to 10 points per class session. To be considered prepared for band; you need to bring the following items to every band class:

- ✓ Instrument: 5 points
- Supplies: Book/Music Sheets, pencil, practice log, instrument accessories (reeds, oil, etc.): up to 3 points
- ✓ Active Performing in Class: 2 points

Performance points will also be subtracted if you are off task or disrupting the class.

CONCERT ATTENDANCE (15% of overall grade)

We will have several concerts during the year. Your attendance at these events is mandatory and a major part of your grade. If you must miss a concert, please submit a signed parent note with a valid excuse to your band teacher either: two weeks before the concert for prearranged absences or within one week after the concert for unexpected absences (sickness, family emergencies, etc). An alternate assignment will be given for excused absences. If you can avoid scheduling elective surgeries/procedures before concerts (especially dental), please do! See the band calendar on the band webpage so you can ensure your attendance at all concerts this year.

ABSENCE MAKE-UP WORK POLICY: Students have the amount of days absent plus one to complete the make-up work and have the absence cleared (per WCSD policy).

MISSING/LATE WORK POLICY: Students will have one week from the due date to complete and turn in to receive partial credit on any assignment. After one week, the assignment will NOT be accepted. Students who are missing work due to office approved absences, see the "Absence Make-Up Work Policy."

CITIZENSHIP (Behavior/Work Ethic)

My rules for citizenship are really basic manners that I hope you have acquired before this class: 5pts per week

- ✓ Be respectful to teacher and fellow classmates
- ✓ Do not talk or play out of turn
- ✓ NO GUM, FOOD, CANDY, or DRINKS in the Band Room (water is okay)
- ✓ Employ all the elements of the "BIGHORN ATTITUDE"

DISCIPLINE PLAN

I will follow the discipline plan that is described in your student planner.

Intermediate(7th) & Advanced (8th) Band Supplies

Every student is responsible for providing the following supplies for 7th/8th grade band class by August 21st, 2024:

- 1) **Instrument** Flute, Oboe*, Bassoon*, Clarinet, Bass Clarinet, Alto/Tenor/Baritone Sax, Trumpet, French Horn*, Trombone, Baritone, Tuba or Percussion* (* = by special permission only)
- 2) Band book: Essential Elements 2000 Book 1 (for Intermediate Band) or Book 2 (for Advanced Band) (this is provided as part of your band fee)
- 3) **Portable Music Stand** (optional for practice at home)
- 4) Pocket Folder (used to hold book, theory worksheets, and additional sheet music)
- 5) Pencil (keep a pencil in your instrument case, we will use them daily!)

6) Additional Accessories for individual instrument:

<u>Flute</u>

- -Cleaning rod (normally included with instrument)
- -Swab for rod (any rectangular piece of cotton is fine)
- -Polishing cloth

<u>Double Reeds/Clarinet/Bass Clarinet/</u> <u>Saxophones</u>

- -Reeds 1 box of 2.5 hardness Vandoren or 3 hardness Rico Royal
- -Cleaning Swab (Bass Cl & Bari Sax-swab included with rental)
- -Cork Grease
- -Neck Strap & Polishing cloth (sax only)

<u>Percussion</u>

Must pay a school rental fee of \$50.

This includes instrument use, a percussion kit

and one pair of drum sticks.

Trombone

- -Slide Cream
- -Polishing Cloth

Trumpet/French Horn/ Baritone/Tuba

- -Valve Oil (Rotor oil for horn)
- -Polishing Cloth

Band Uniform

We will wear our uniform at all concerts and events. The uniform includes:

- -Your band polo (Polo orders to be taken week 3) tucked in
- -Solid black dress pants (dress pants preferred, but nice solid dark black jeans would be acceptable)
- -Solid black dress shoes (no white stripes), socks and belt (belt not required if not needed)





Band Instrument Rental/Purchase Procedures

Rental/Purchase Options:

- Rent-to-own from a local music store (or online). Approximate Prices: \$30-45/month for flute, clarinet, trumpet and trombone. Saxes and larger instrument are around \$50-80/month. (Some pricing can be found on the band website)
- Purchase from a local music store or online (do not recommend this option for beginners). If you are going to purchase, Mr.
- Myers is happy to give input about instrument quality and price. Remember- you get what you pay for! NO AMAZON

 Rent instrument from the school for \$50 for the school year (Limited inventory- reserved first for those on the Free & Reduced Lunch list per district policy).

Rental Procedures:

- □ **From Music Stores**: Families review prices from different stores (some store rental rates and info can be found on the Billinghurst Band webpage, info below) and then go in to rent/buy.
- Percussionists: Percussion kits available from the school via submission of School Rental Application (next page). \$50 Rental fee.

 For School instruments: Parents who need a school instrument submit a request when filling out the Band Information Form (online). The list of those in need is then given to our Principal to check Free & Reduced Lunch eligibility. If the student qualifies and an instrument is available, Mr. Myers will then send home a rental contract. Students will not receive school instruments unless Mr. Myers has received contract and payment. Qualifying students still pay the \$50 rental fee. (Different from Class Fee)
 - o If you don't need a school instrument, but would like to use one if Mr. Myers has any left over after those in need have checked theirs out, please complete the form below as well.
