Freshmen Elective Course Descriptions

ART	Art is an introductory class designed to give students a background for both understanding and producing quality visual art.		
BEGINNING ROCK/POP ENSEMBLE	A beginner group centered around playing rock/pop music. While the class is centered around guitar playing, other instruments students will learn in this group are electric bass, drum set, vocals, and keyboard.		
CERAMICS	This introductory course focuses on the skills and knowledge that students need to create ceramic sculpture and pottery.		
CONCERT BAND	A beginner group focused on playing concert band/wind ensemble music. This ensemble is perfect for beginner level students who are seeking to learn how to play band instruments. Instruments in this group include: trumpet, trombone, baritone/euphonium, tuba, saxophone, clarinet, bass clarinet, oboe, flute, double bass, and all percussion instruments.		
CONCERT ORCHESTRA	Ensemble that focuses on string-based orchestral music. This group consists of the instruments Violin, Viola, Cello, and Double Bass.		
CULINARY ARTS	This course provides the principles, chemistry, and techniques of food preparation.		
DRAMA	This course is designed for the beginning theatre student who is interested in learning the fundamentals of theatre arts.		
ENGINEERING	The major focus is the design process and its application through hands-on projects, students apply engineering standards. E.g. 3D modeling		
MARIACHI	This ensemble focuses on music from the Mariachi tradition. Instruments included in this ensemble are: guitar, vihuela, guitarrón, violin, trumpet, and vocals. Open to students of all levels and interest.		
MILITARY SCIENCE	This course introduces students to the fundamentals of Military Science. Areas of emphasis include introduction to JROTC, foundation of leadership, citizenship, wellness, physical fitness, and first aid.		
SPANISH	This course is an introductory level to world language learning.
