August

- Research/ visit colleges

September

- Register and take SAT or ACT, if needed
- Attend Senior Evening Program
- Create a Common Application account
- Begin to research scholarships

October

- Nevada Bound
- Early Applications are due for some colleges
- Attend a College Fair
- Begin to ask teachers for Letters of Recommendations
- Prepare for FAFSA (get FSA ID)

November

- Early Applications are due for some colleges (check colleges website)
- Create an NCAA Eligibility Center account, if applicable
- Consider taking ASVAB, if applicable

December

- Submit college applications
- Last chance to take ACT and/or SAT exam
- College early decisions being to arrive
- **FAFSA is available**

January

- Continue to submit application
- Prepare for IHS Scholarship

March

- Review financial aid award letters
- Keep an eye out on FAFSA deadlines

May

- May 1st is "National College Decision Day"
- Register and take AP exams, if applicable
