



ARCHITECTURE SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

AIA Northern Nevada, a chapter of the American Institute of Architects, is pleased to announce a call for applications for the **2024 Ric Licata Memorial Scholarship**. The scholarship is named for noted northern Nevada architect Ric Licata, FAIA, and consists of a monetary award to a student (or students) meeting the following criteria:

- ◆ Funds are dedicated for students engaged in Truckee Meadows Community College's
 - ◆ Architecture, AAS
 - ◆ Landscape Architecture, AAS
 - ◆ Residential Design, AAS
- ◆ Must be one of the following:
 - 1] A high school senior accepted to one of the programs listed above.
 - 2] A student currently attending one of the programs listed above.
- ◆ Demonstrate leadership skills and future leadership potential as well as financial need on the application form.

Funds for this scholarship have come from a commitment of AIA Northern Nevada and AIA National Scholarship Grant Program honoring the lifelong commitment to architectural education and professional leadership demonstrated by Ric Licata, FAIA. Ric Licata was an active member of the TMCC faculty for 23 years while maintaining a professional career in Northern Nevada spanning over 40 years. Ric became a nationally recognized figure in architectural advocacy and sustainability through his many leadership positions and thoughtful initiatives within the American Institute of Architects ranging from local to state, regional to national. His dedication and leadership as an active and effective advocate on behalf of the profession of architecture serves as a continuing legacy for emerging leaders to take initiative and design a better world. Through his extraordinary commitment to leadership, his contributions transcended the field of architecture for the betterment of society at large. This scholarship seeks to assist in recognizing deserving students who have or are currently demonstrating a commitment to leadership and potential in designing the profession of the future. Financial need and other thoughts of equity are also taken into consideration in the selection process.

The information provided on your application, together with your letters of recommendation and transcripts will be treated confidentially and used to evaluate your degree of scholastic promise, level of achievement, degree of need and other aspects of your eligibility. The 2024 Licata scholarship(s) will be determined by the AIA Northern Nevada scholarship committee and **announced in August 2024**. The award may be a single scholarship or multiple scholarships.
