



WHO WE SELECT

Cooke College Scholarship recipients are selected from a nationwide applicant pool each year. At a minimum, students must:

- Complete four years of high school in the U.S., a U.S territory, or on a U.S. military base and plan to graduate in spring 2025.
- Intend to enroll full time in an accredited 4-year college in fall 2025.
- Earn a cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.75 or above in high school.
- Demonstrate financial need.
 We will consider applicants
 with a maximum annual family
 gross income of \$95,000. Last
 year's recipients had a median
 family income of approximately
 \$34,000. During the selection
 process, a full financial review
 will take into account all income
 and assets of the student and the
 student's parents.

First Generation College Student Supports



The TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) Program is seeking eligible students who meet the following requirements:

- FIRST GENERATION: Neither parent or legal guardians, completed a Bachelor's Degree AND/OR
- INCOME QUALIFIED: Determination is made based on taxable income from previous year AND/OR
- DOCUMENTED DISABILITY: Student may also be eligible if they have a documented disability
- Applicants must also meet both of the following requirements:
- ACADEMIC NEED: Determined by a variety of academic and admissions criteria
- U.S. CITIZEN (or eligible non-citizen/resident alien):



- First in the Pack
 - a program designed to help first-generation and/or Nevada Guarantee college students obtain a college degree.
- Fostering the Pack
 - a program designed to help college students who have experienced foster care through the state of Nevada after the age of 13 and are under 26 obtain a college degree.
- Trio Scholars and Trio Stem Scholars
 - TRIO's mission is to assist income-qualified, first-generation University of Nevada, Reno students to overcome the cultural, academic, class and socioeconomic barriers to success in higher education through services provided during their entire college career..
- Upward Bound classic and Upward Bound math+science
 - Upward Bound supports first-generation, income-qualified students at eight target high schools with free college prep services, fostering skills for successful postsecondary education. UBMS focuses on math and science to promote pursuing degrees in those fields.

YOU SHOULD FILL OUT THE FAFSA

Not really sure whether you or your child should fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid or whether it affects you?

You should — and it probably does.



IT'S FREE

The FAFSA doesn't cost anything to complete.



The application has been majorly simplified over the past few years — and there are helpful pointers throughout.



IT'S FAST.

It takes most students just 23 minutes to complete the FAFSA: less time than it would take to watch your favorite show.



YOU PROBABLY QUALIFY.

More people qualify for federal student aid than you think — chances are, you're leaving money on the table by not applying.



IT MAY BE REQUIRED.

Many states, schools, and private scholarships require you to submit the FAFSA before they'll consider you for any financial aid.

IOW DO I BECOME A MILLENNIUM SCHOLAR?

Students will be eligible when **all** the following conditions are met

- Earn at least a 3.25 GPA (weighted or unweighted) or a qualifying test score of 1070 on the SAT or 21 on the ACT. ACT superscores are not accepted. Only composite scores from a single test date will be considered.
 Complete the following core curriculum: 4 units in English, 4 units in Math (including Algebra II or higher), 3 units in Science, 3 units in
- All requirements must be met by the date of high school graduation.

MATRICULATION PROCESS

There is no application process for traditional students that graduate from a Nevada public, private or charter high school. Students qualify by meeting the eligibility requirements listed above. High schools and school districts submit student information for those who have qualified upon high school graduation.

SCHOLARSHIP DISBURSEMENTS

To receive the benefits of the Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship (GGMS), students must enroll in an eligible institution of higher education in Nevada. Please note, receiving the Millennium Scholarship does not guarantee admission to any of Nevada's eligible in-state institutions.

To receive scholarship disbursements as a Millennium Scholar:

- Students must be enrolled in a program of study leading to a recognized associate degree, baccalaureate degree, or pre-baccalaureate certificate.
- Students must be enrolled in at least 9 semester credits at an eligible community college or 12 semester credits at another eligible institution.

MAINTAINING ELIGIBILITY

To maintain eligibility for the GGMS, students must meet three requirements at the end of each semester for which they receive funding.

To maintain eligibility as a Millennium scholar:

- Students must make satisfactory academic progress in their program of study.
- Students must earn at least a 2.75 semester GPA.
- Students must complete at least 9 semester credits at an eligible community college or 12 semester credits at another eligible institution.

If a student fails to meet the minimum requirements in any semester for which they received funding, the student will receive a strike, and the scholarship will be suspended. Eligibility for the Millennium Scholarship can be regained by meeting all the requirements listed above in a subsequent semester. If loss of eligibility is incurred a second time, the student will be permanently removed from the program.

All requirements for the scholarship are outlined in Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 396, Board of Regents Handbook Title 4 Chapter 18, and NSHE Procedures and Guidelines Chapter 12.

- *This information is subject to any changes in State law, policies adopted by the NSHE Board of Regents, availability of funding, and any related matters thereto.
- **Applications for students who did not graduate from a Nevada public, private or charter high school can be found on the GGMS website www.nvggms.gov. ***A qualified SAT/ACT score only replaces a GPA below 3.25.
- Students are still required to meet the other requirements.
