

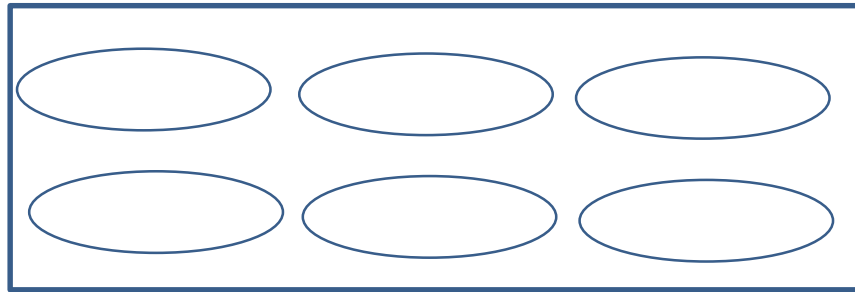


Kidwatching Techniques **Messy Sheet: Reading**

Keep a class sheet to track students who need additional instruction with the targeted skill.

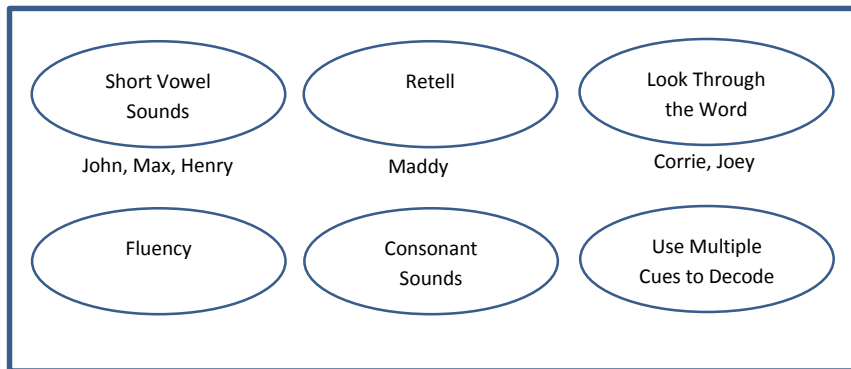
Set Up Messy Sheets

1. Draw up to nine different shapes on a Word document. Type or write specific skills inside each shape. Alternative, type or write the skill on the bottom outside of each shape.
2. Messy Sheets may be created for each month of instruction, for each week, or for a varied time period.



Observe and Record

1. During instruction, write students name inside or on the outside for each skill when you are unable to detect the targeted reading behavior being utilized.



Assess Targeted Goals

1. Refer to the messy sheet to determine which students you need additional instruction in the designated skills. Use this information for upcoming lesson planning.
2. Keep the Messy Sheets for future reference.
