- *Handheld, tablet, or laptop computers, including PDA's
- *Electronic writing pads or pen-input devices
- *Calculators built into cell phones, IPODS, mP3 players, watches or any other electronic communication devices.
- *Calculators with an infrared data port

Can I use a calculator?

Calculator policies are designed to ensure fairness for all examinees, avoid disturbances in the testing room, and protect the security of the test materials.

College Board and ACT Calculator Policy Information

Calculators permitted during college readiness and entrance exams include:

- Most graphing calculators (review list of allowable calculators for each test)
- All scientific calculators
- All four-function calculators (not recommended)

It is the student's responsibility to know whether a particular calculator is permitted.

ACT

A permitted calculator may be used on the ACT mathematics test only (ACT Calculator Policy, effective September 1, 2014).

When you take the PSAT/NMSQT you can use a calculator for part of the Math Test, but it has to be an approved type.
