Grading Procedures

*Jazz Band grade band grades will be determined using the assessment areas below.

ASSESSMENTS (20% of overall grade)

- Playing Tests: These will be once per quarter so each student may receive feedback to aid their progress. Students may retest for higher until the end of each quarter. Feedback and progress reports will also be given each test.
- Written Assessments: Students show knowledge of music literacy (note names, music reading, symbols, terms, etc.)
- > <u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> You will *always* be given ample notification and will only be tested on concepts/exercises we have covered in class. If you are practicing regularly, these tests should be no problem.



PRACTICE (30% of overall grade)

Home practice is a critical element of playing an instrument. Students will complete weekly practice goals and then submit a practice log (can be found both online and in class). 30 completed goals are considered a 100% and students may complete up to 42 goals for extra credit. Students should set aside about 120 minutes a week for practice and are encouraged to divide this time up evenly throughout the week. Late work will be graded at 60% after the due date and will NOT be accepted after one week past due.

PARTICIPATION (40% of overall grade)

Your participation is graded according to your preparedness and active participation in class. You may receive up to 20 points per class session. To be considered prepared for band; you need to bring the following items to every band class:

* Instrument: 10 points * Music Book: 5 points * Pencil, Practice Log, Additional Sheet Music, instrument accessories (reeds, oils, etc.): 5 points total. Participation points will also be subtracted if you are off task and/or disrupting the class.

CONCERT ATTENDANCE (10% of overall grade)

We will have several concerts during the year. **Concert participation is MANDAROTY** and a large part of your grade. If you must miss a concert, please email Mr. Scarbrough at least two weeks before or within 24 hours after the concert. Absences are excused at the director's discretion. PLEASE NOTE: Non-school related sports or team practices, games, or competitions <u>DO NOT</u> qualify as an excused absence. An alternate assignment will be given for excused absences. If you can avoid scheduling elective surgeries/procedures before concerts (especially dental), please do! See the band calendar and the band webpage so you can ensure your attendance at all concerts this year.

ABSENCE MAKE UP WORK POLICY: If a student misses a class, he or she must make up the missed playing time be coming into the band room at lunch/after school to practice. Students must practice the assignments given, and rehearse the music covered in class that day. 20 minutes is required for a missed regular day, and 40 minutes for a missed block day. Students have the amount of days absent to make up the work to have the absence cleared (per WCSD policy).

CLASSROOM RULES AND EXPECTATIONS: As with any other classroom, certain rules and expectations are placed upon all students. The band room rules are: 1) No talking while the teacher(s) is working. 2) No food, gum, candy, or flavored drinks. Water is okay. 3) Only handle your personal belongings - DO NOT touch instruments, music, or equipment that is not yours. 4) Come prepared **every day**. 5) Leave the room in better condition than you found it – chairs and stands tidy, instruments and music on assigned shelves, take all your belongings, no trash on the floor, etc.

The expectations for every student are: 1) Make good choices – If you must ask if it's okay to do something, it probably isn't. 2) Use appropriate language both musically and socially. 3) Show respect to everyone. 4) Involve yourself (we only succeed if EVERYONE puts forth 100%). 5) Care for our room and instruments.

DISCIPLINE PLAN:

I will use a progressive discipline plan should students choose not to follow the rules and expectations. If student repeats these behaviors regularly, he or she may be removed from band for the remainder of the year.

- 1- Verbal correction and instructions for solution
- "Time out" from rehearsal for a short time and parental notification
- 3- Removal from rehearsal for remainder of class, parent notification, write up in IC
- 4- Removal from classroom, parent notification, IC write up, and administration involvement.

CITIZENSHIP (Weekly grades will be given for behavior and work ethic)

My policy for citizenship is basic manners, which I hope you have acquired before this class:

- Be respectful to teacher, instruments, and fellow classmates
- Do not talk or play out of turn
- Enter and leave classroom quietly and orderly
- RISE to the occasion



 $\underline{ \textbf{Supplies Needed-Jazz Band}} \\ \text{Every student is responsible for providing the following supplies for band class}$

- 1) **Instrument*** choices and needed supplies are listed below
- 2) Music Book: Standard of Excellence in Jazz Book 1 for your instrument. All other music will be provided in class
- 3) **Pencil** (keep a pencil in your instrument case, we will use them daily!)
- Maintenance supplies and accessories for individual instrument:

SAXOPHONE

- Reeds (1 box; Rico brand, size 2.5 3)
- Cleaning Swab
- Cork Grease
- Neckstrap
- Polishing cloth

TROMBONE

- Slide Cream/Oil
- Mini water spray bottle - Polishing cloth

TRUMPET

- Valve Oil
- Slide Grease - Polishing cloth

Bass/Guitar

- patch cord for amplifiers
- anything else you need to play (straps, tuners, extra strings, etc.)

Drums

- 1 Stick bag
- 1 pair 5A Drumsticks
- 1 pair brushes
- 1 drum key

Band Performance Uniform

We will wear a unique performance uniform at all concerts. Students out of uniform will be asked to change immediately or be sent home from the performance. The uniform includes:

- Band T-Shirt - Nice Pants (no holes or fray) - Closed Toed Shoes



Band Instrument Rental/Purchase Procedures 2020-2021

Rental/Purchase Options:

- Rent from a local music store (or online). Prices: \$30 50 per month. Music stores and locations are available on the Herz Music
- Purchase from a local music store or online (not recommended for beginners). If you are going to purchase, Mr. Scarbrough is happy to give input about instrument quality and price.
- School Instrument rentals are available for \$50 for the school year. Limited inventory on popular instruments (trumpets, saxophones, and clarinets. Reserved first for those on the FRL program).

Rental Procedures:

- Music Stores: Families review prices from different stores and then go in to rent.
- School-owned instruments: Parents who need a school instrument submit a School Rental Application (attached). Instruments are distributed on first come first serve basis. For all school-owned instruments, Mr. Scarbrough will then send home a rental contract. Students will not receive school instruments until Mr. Scarbrough has received the completed contract and payment. Each instrument has a required \$50 rental fee.

Private Lessons

It is strongly recommended that students enroll in private lessons. In a private lesson, your child would meet with a specialist on their instrument on a regular basis for 1:1 instruction to address issues that can get overlooked in a large-rehearsal setting. Students enrolled in private lessons will often become the most advanced students in class as well as create collegiate scholarship opportunities. If interested, please contact Mr. Scarbrough for teacher recommendations and good questions to ask.



Adjust your Infinite Campus Message Settings

Please adjust your Infinite Campus Message settings to allow teacher messages to go directly to your email. This is very handy for grade warnings and other important class information for band and all classes. For instructions about how to adjust your settings, visit the band website (www.washoeschools.net/herzmusic) under Announcements. There is a link here that will take you to the instructions.

School Instrument Rental Application (Optional)

- Visit the Herz Band website and complete the School Instrument Rental online form (the link is towards the bottom of the page). If you do not have internet access, please ask Mr. Scarbrough for a paper form.
- Only complete this form if school instrument is needed. This does not guarantee that you will receive an instrument. This lets Mr. Scarbrough know that you would like an instrument from the school. Please understand that the school has limited instruments available. Large or less common instruments are available to rent from the school without being in financial need. These include: oboe, bassoon, bass clarinet, tenor/bari sax, French horn, trombone, baritone/euphonium, tuba and percussion kits.
- Those needing a school instrument need to complete the online form by Friday, August 13th by 2:30 PM
