Virtual Classes for Families Hosted by School Sites and Supported by Parent U -Schools can schedule online courses from our catalog with Parent University that will focus on building the capacity of families to support math, literacy, science, social and emotional learning, technology, transitions between school levels and how to navigate the pathway to college and highly skilled careers.



Kinder Kick-Offs - In partnership with the C & I Kindergarten Coordinator, we are supporting Kindergarten teachers, who have opted in to these supports, to initiate strong, positive relationships with our newest families in WCSD. Kindergarten teachers will be supported to create a virtual space for families to connect and build a classroom community.

Family Literacy Club Cohort – for Teachers - (School-Based Site – K – 3rd) - Parent U and NWRPDP will work with 21 elementary teachers to build their capacity to cultivate sustainable partnerships with their families while also building the capacity of their families to support literacy at home.

Parent Teacher Bridge Visits: Parent Teacher Bridge Visits replaces the in-person two visit model of Parent Teacher Home Visits to keep families and staff connected during Covid-19. Bridge Visits give families and school staff the opportunity to build meaningful relationships virtually during physical distancing. Participating schools, that applied last Spring and were selected, will have a certified site coordinator to support the school's home visit team and will meet with Family-School Partnerships monthly via Teams or Zoom. A virtual version of the Introduction to Parent Teacher Home Visits/Bridge Visits Professional learning will be provided to all new home visitors.
