How is College different from High School?

- ▶ You set your own schedule
 - ▶ Classes on specific days
- ▶ Classes are credit based and different (most 3 credits)
- ▶ 1 credit = amount of time IN class
- ▶ Expect to do 1-3 hours of homework OUTSIDE of class per credit
- ▶ A lot of responsibility on the student to make sure they are in the right class
- ▶ You pay for the classes
- ▶ Typically you take 4-5 classes a semester
- ▶ Pick new classes every semester

Application Day



- ▶ When: TBA (before UNR's EA deadline of 11/15)
 - ▶ Priority for scholarships, financial assistance, classes/schedule
- ▶ Where: During the day
- ▶ What: Apply to colleges during school!
- ▶ UNR and TMCC will be here to help, but you can apply anywhere

Placing into College Level (Eng 101/Math 120)

You will take the 3 credit ENG 101 or 102

You will take the 3 credit MATH 120 or 126

If you don't place into College level

You will take 5 credit ENG 100 class

You will take MATH 120+20 (4 credits)
Or a 5 or 6 credit MATH 126+26

Alternate Placement Options

TMCC—Based on unweighted GPA and specific courses, Accuplacer score

UNR—Writing portfolio (English), ALEKS (math)


Nevada Guarantee (UNR)

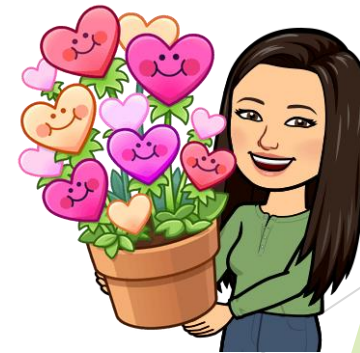
