HOW DO I BECOME A MILLENNIUM SCHOLAR?

Students in the Graduating Classes of 2017* and later will be eligible when all the following conditions have been met:

- Graduate with a Nevada high school diploma**
- Earn at least a 3.25 GPA (weighted or unweighted) or a qualifying test score *** (1070 on the SAT or 21 on the ACT)
- Complete the following core curriculum: 4 units in English, 4 units in Math (including Algebra II or higher), 3 units in Science, 3 units in Social Science or History
- Be a Nevada resident for at least two years of their high school career

All requirements must be met by the date of high school graduation.

- Available for ALL Nevada students!!
- Scholarship only for Nevada Colleges or Universities





Nevada System of Higher Education

NEVADA PROMISE

SCHOLARSHIP

- Truckee Meadows Community College (TMCC)
- Open to high school seniors
- The scholarship will provide up to three years or no cost registration fee and other mandatory fees to eligible students.
- · Must complete steps to earn the award.


STEP 1:





Select your account. You will be directed to your Microsoft Office account page with your name and your email address.








