We believe that students should have personal agency over their behavior and actions. Please follow all teacher and school expectations.

In order to provide consistent learning and practice, all assignments are due on the designated due date. If general class assignments are turned in late, they will be evaluated on a **MAXIMUM of 70%** of the original value. The LATEST any assignment can be turned in is ONE WEEK before the end of the quarter. Without advance notice, special projects/activities may not be accepted late as deemed by the instructor.
