HONORS MUSIC CREDIT REQUIREMENTS
FOR GRADES 10-12

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the honors music requirements have been adjusted so students are able to earn honors credit but meet the rigor required by an honors course.

two choices for this school year are checked below.

1. Sign contract stating intent to participate in honor music credit requirements.
2. Choose two from the following list:
 - a. Attend private lessons, a minimum of 2 times per month for the entire school year (10 per semester) to be verified by private teacher.
 - b. Tutor a less experienced musician, a minimum of 2 times per month for the entire school year (10 per semester) to be pre-approved by the teacher.
 - c. An analytical, research, policy or advocacy paper, in addition to and longer than any assigned in the "regular" syllabus.
 - d. A service-learning experience or internship related to the course focus.
 - e. An audio/video project, performance, or artistic work related to the course focus.
 - f. Development of a portfolio that may be used for a college submission.
 - g. Prepare a piece for the NAFME student composer/songwriter competition.
 - h. Create a series of videos teaching younger students several concepts in your course focus.
 - i. Create a virtual show relating to your course focus – design everything including a set list, program, advertisement etc.
 - j. Another pre-arranged project approved by the teacher.

Details and dates to be worked out by music teacher and student and may differ from school to school and ensemble to ensemble (i.e. band, choir, orchestra).
