"To apply for federal student aid, such as federal grants, work-study, and loans, you need to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®). Completing and submitting the FAFSA is free and easier than ever, and it gives you access to the largest source of financial aid to pay for college or career school. In addition, many states and colleges use your FAFSA information to determine your eligibility for state and school aid, and some private financial aid providers may use your FAFSA information to determine whether you qualify for their aid."

## WHAT WILL I NEED?

### STUDENT HAS A SSN & PARENTS FILE TAXES USING A SSN

- Student and Parent 2020 Federal Income Tax Forms (If student worked)
- Separate Student & parent FSA IDs & Passwords
- Student & parent social security numbers

### STUDENT HAS A SSN & PARENTS FILE TAXES USING AN ITIN

- Student and Parent 2020 Federal Income Tax Forms (If student worked)
- Student only FSA ID & Password
- Student SSN & parents' ITIN
- Enter in all 0's in FAFSA application instead of SSN

### STUDENT HAS A SSN & PARENTS DO NOT HAVE A SSN/ITIN & DO NOT FILE TAXES

- Student 2020 Federal Income Tax Forms (If student worked)
- Student only FSA ID & Password
- Student SSN

### PARENTS AND STUDENT DO NOT HAVE A SSN & PARENTS DO/DO NOT FILE TAXES

In this case, you will fill out (if applicable) a non-FAFSA form at the University or College you are attending.

For example: At UNR you will fill out an "Institutional Methodology" form and at TMCC you will fill out a "Non FAFSA Filer Form".

# Meet our Deans!



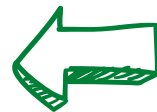
**CRYS JACKSON**

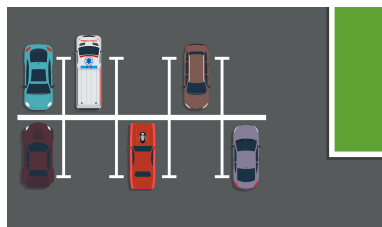
# DEAN'S UPDATES



This is a friendly reminder that ALL students are required to follow our adopted dress code policy from the district. This is a reminder that clothing must cover from chest to mid-thigh; including the midriff/stomach area, undergarments such as boxers, underwear, and/or bras must not be intentionally exposed, and sunglasses may not be worn inside the building. Students may be subject to consequences for repeated dress code violations. Please refer to the posted policy found on our school website.



To ensure safety and security, students will not be allowed in the parking lot while classes are in session or during lunch. Also, students may not open the doors to the exterior to let students or any person enter the building. Students may not prop open a door with any object. All visitors and students who need to enter the building during the school day must enter through the main office and show identification.



Students are not allowed to eat lunch in the stairwell areas or in the student parking lot. Due to fire code, safety, and security issues, lunch access will no longer be available in these areas. Lunch access will continue in the commons, informal learning spaces on the 2nd, and 3rd floors, the media center, teacher approved classrooms, the hallways throughout the campus, and the exterior areas of campus that include the tennis bleachers, patio areas, and practice fields.
