SSW's are licensed mental health professionals who can assist with mental health concerns, behavioral concerns, family support, positive behavioral support, academic and classroom support, consultation with teachers, parents, and administrators, as well as provide individual and group intervention.

WHAT

In Washoe County a SSW must have a Master's degree in Social Work, be a licensed Social Worker through the State of Nevada Board of Examiners for Social Work, and have a SSW Endorsement from the Nevada Department of Education.

WHY

SSW's are a link between the home, school, and community in providing direct as well as indirect services to students, families and school personnel to promote and support students' academic and social success.
