Reno, NV 89502 (Entrance on Golden Lane)

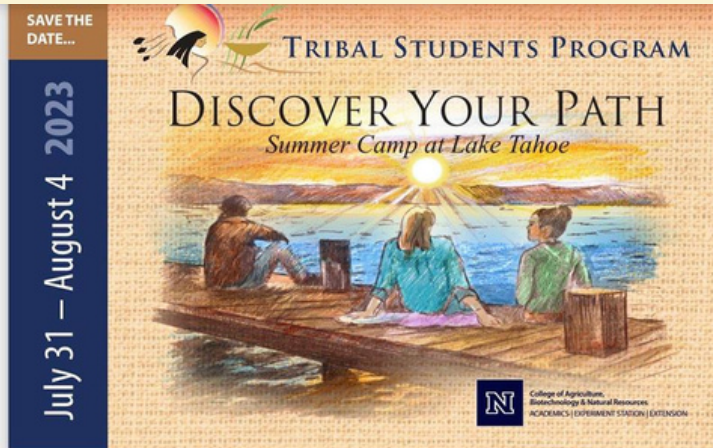
