## Course Description Example

#### Speech and Debate

Course #6411-6412

Full year = 1 credit

Fee: \$50 + Tournament and Transportation Fees\*

This course will provide students with basic knowledge of debate theory and technique and instruction in public and competitive speaking. The course will include instruction in ten types of formal speeches, three categories of debate, and Student Congress. Students will review and analyze famous speeches of the past, as well as write and analyze speeches of today. Participation in speech and debate tournaments outside of school hours, approximately four per semester are required. Course goals: Students will develop knowledge of debate theory and speaking ability which will allow them to compete in interscholastic competition. Students will learn logical structure, reasoning, and analysis of argumentation. \*Tournament fees vary based upon tournament locations. This course requires course work outside of the traditional school day as part of the academic grade.

## Choosing a Math class

- If you are taking Algebra 1 in 8<sup>th</sup> grade and are struggling, we recommend repeating Algebra 1 as a freshman
- If you earn A's or B's both semesters of Algebra 1 in 8<sup>th</sup> grade, we recommend taking Formal Geometry 1-2(Honors) or Geometry 1-2 in 9<sup>th</sup> grade
- Students currently taking 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Math will enroll in Algebra 1 for 9<sup>th</sup> grade
- If you are on an IEP, your case manager will recommend an appropriate math course

## Recommended Classes for Freshmen

PE OR Military Science

4 semesters of PE/Military Science are required

Health and Computer Science

Need 1 semester of each to graduate

## Computer Literacy & Health Graduation Requirements

The following course is the only course that will satisfy the computer literacy requirement for graduation:

8344 Computer Science and Applications (one semester)

The following courses will satisfy the health requirement for graduation:

- 5311 Health
- 34201/34202 Principles of Health Science (must be accepted to Sports Medicine Academy & must pass both semesters)
- 5<sup>th</sup> semester of Military Science counts for Health if student successfully completes all five semesters
