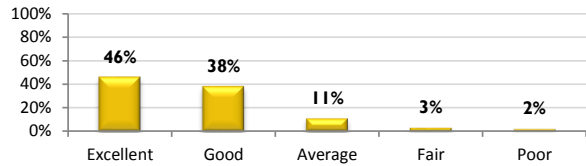
Your school returned 8454 parent climate surveys.

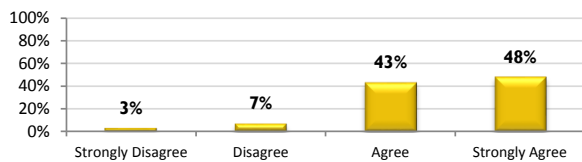

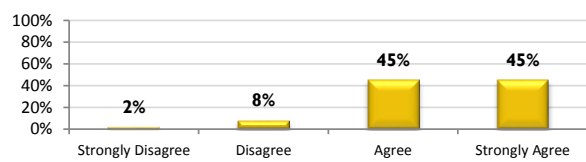
46% of parents gave your school an "excellent" rating.

Supportive Place



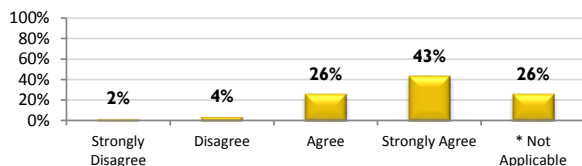
91% of parents agree that the school is welcoming and supportive of parent involvement.

Quality Education



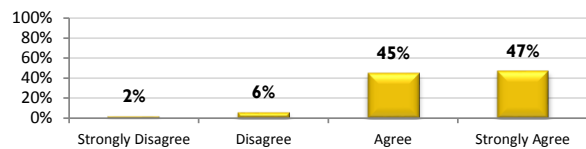
90% of parents agree that their child is receiving a high quality education.

Contact with Personnel



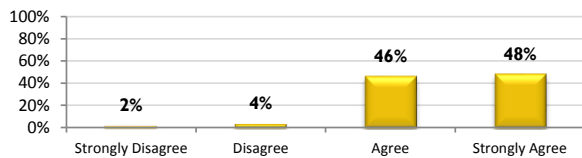
92% of parents agree that their contact with school personnel has been positive. (*"N/A" excluded from calculation)

Communication with School



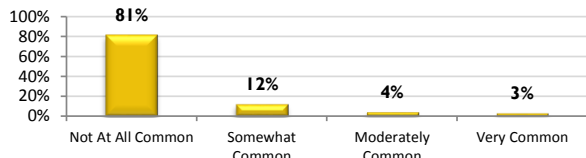
92% of parents agree that their child's school does a good job communicating with them about their child's learning.

Safety



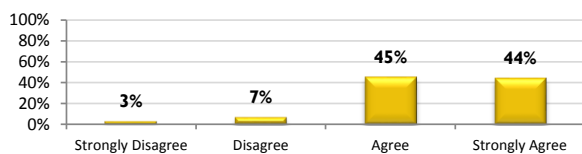
94% of parents agree that their child feels safe inside and outside the school.

Student Behavior



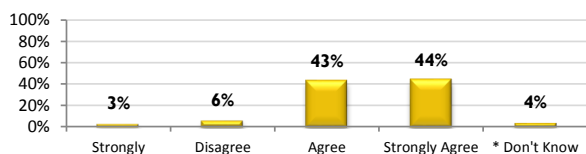
93% of parents agree that student risk-taking behaviors are only somewhat or not at all common.
