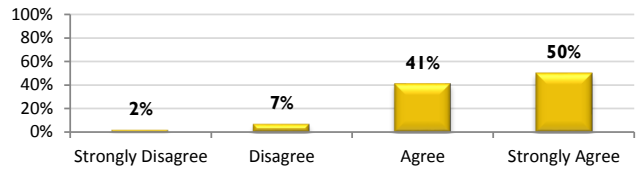
Your school returned 3705 climate surveys.

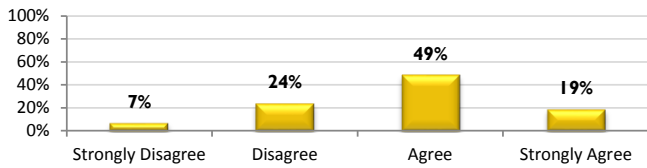

### Adult Respect



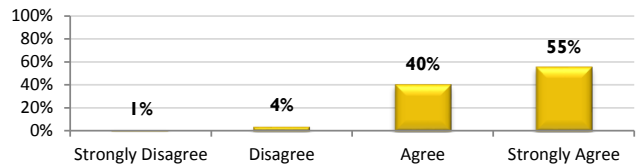
**91%** of students agree that adults respect students at their school.

### Student Respect



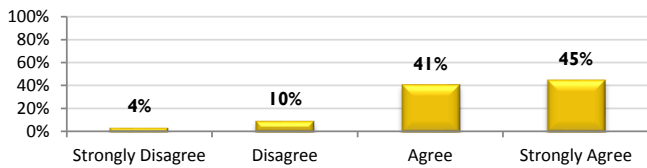
**69%** of students agree that their peers are respectful of each other.

### Parent Engagement



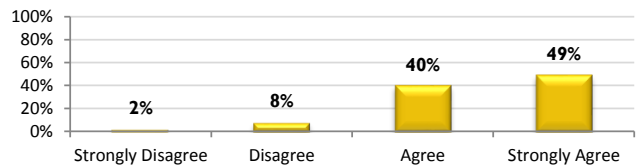
**94%** of students agree that their parents are involved in the learning process.

### Adult Caring



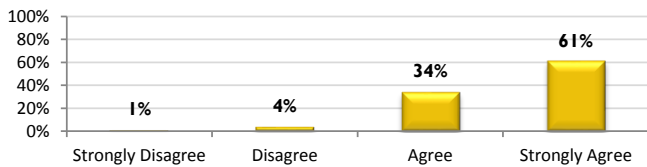
**86%** of students agree that adults at their school care how they are doing.

### Academic Support



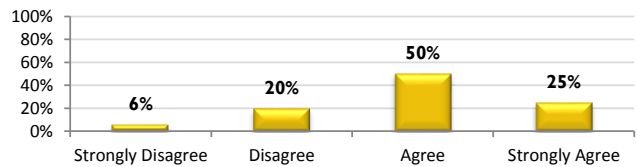
**90%** of students agree that adults provide the academic support needed to do well in school.

### Academic Commitment



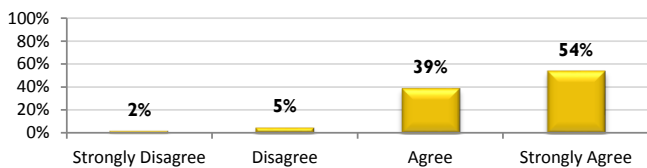
**95%** of students agree that they are committed to doing well in school.

### Student Engagement



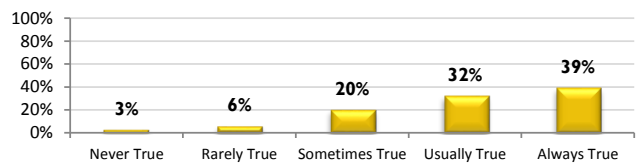
**75%** of students agree that they are academically engaged in their coursework.
