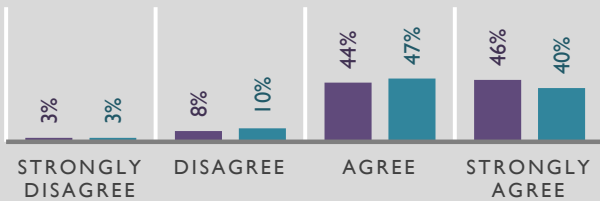

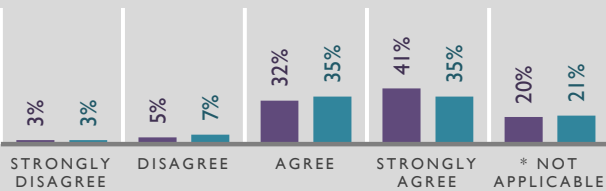
Supportive Place School District

91% of parents agree that their contact with school personnel has been positive. (*N/A excluded from calculation)



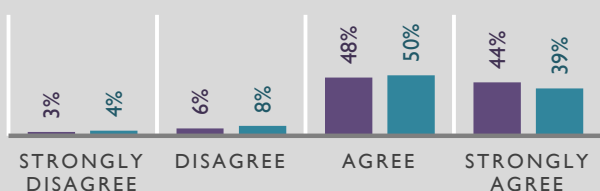
Safety

95% of parents agree that their child feels safe inside and outside the school.



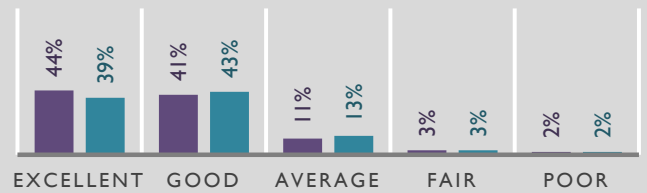
Adult Caring

91% of parents agree that adults at their child's school care how their child is doing.



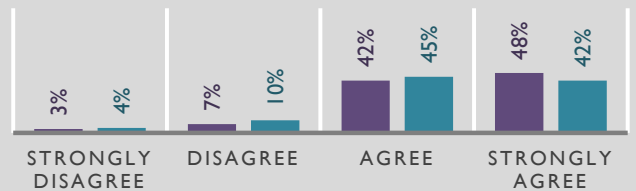

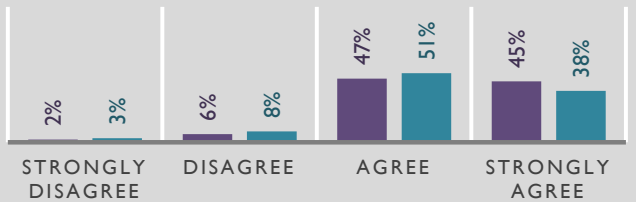
Quality Education

89% of parents agree that their child is receiving a high quality education. (*Don't Know excluded from calculation)



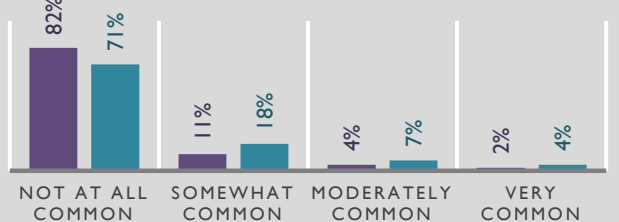
Communication with School

92% of parents agree that their child's school does a good job communicating with them about their child's learning.



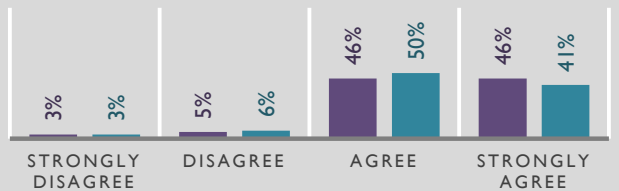
Student Behavior
