


Q.1: How supported do you feel this year to use the new ELA instructional materials (Benchmark) to teach the ELA Nevada Academic Content Standards?












Q.4: The rules and expectations about how students should behave at my school are fair.








Q.1: How many of your students' parents/guardians






Q.2: How many of your students' parents/guardians have asked you about ways they can support their child's learning at home?




Q.3: How many of your students' parents/guardians know how well their child is doing in your class?








Q.5: Every single student at our school knows at least one staff member who would care if they were not in school.











Q.7: How common are the following behaviors at this school? Racial/ethnic conflict among students






Q.10: How common are the following behaviors at this school? Cutting classes or being truant



Q.12: How common are the following behaviors at this school? Weapons possession




Q.13: How common are the following behaviors at this school? Vandalism (including graffiti)


