




Q.1: I am kept informed about my child's ongoing learning and progress.



Q.2: My child's teacher(s) are available to discuss my child's learning needs with me.




Q.3: I am kept informed about my child's behavior.










Q.1: What grade is your child currently in at this school? (Please select only ONE)




Q.2: Does your child receive free or reduced price lunch?



Q.3: What is your race or ethnicity? (Please select only ONE.)




Q.4: What is the best time of day for you to attend school workshops or events? (Please SELECT ALL THAT APPLY)




Q.1: How confident are you that you can help your child develop good friendships?




Q.3: How confident are you that you can motivate your child to try hard in school?










Q.2: How often does your child struggle to get organized for school?






Q.4: How much effort does your child put into schoolrelated tasks?



Q.6: When working on school activities at home, how easily is your child distracted?






Q.7: On average, how well does your child work independently on learning activities at home?






Q.1: My child is receiving the kind of instruction that is appropriate for his or her abilities.




Q.3: My child's teacher(s) provide my child with all of the accommodations needed to do well in his or her classes.














Q.1: How much of a sense of belonging does your child feel at his/her school?


Q.2: How comfortable is your child in asking for help from school adults?


Q.3: Given your child's cultural background, how good a fit is his/her school?


Q.4: How well do you feel your child's school is preparing him/her for his/her next academic year?


Q.5: How well do the activities offered at your child's school match his/her interests?






Q.1: School employees make me feel welcome at my child's school.




