




Q.1: How are you using the time provided on early release Wednesdays? (please select up to three options)










Q.1: How many of your students' parents/guardians support your teaching efforts?


**Q.3: How many of your students' parents/guardians** know how well their child is doing in your class?













### Q.5: How prepared do you feel to teach Math Nevada Academic Content Standards?
