Student Success Goal

By the end of the 2023-24 school year, 50% of students will score at grade level or above on iReady Diagnostics in both ELA and Math.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. English Language Development (ELD) facilitator and Learning Facilitator (BLF) will continue to attend professional learning around coaching and professional development.
2. ELD and BLF to attend Professional Learning Communities (PLC) and grade level meetings to support planning, data analysis, intervention, and enrichment planning.
3. Teachers use Leveled Literacy program for English Language Arts (ELA) intervention groups.
4. Teacher use Envision/Bridges intervention programs for intervention groups in Math.
5. All students included in Tier I ELA and Math instruction using language acquisition strategies (Guided Language Acquisition Design, Ellevation).
6. Teachers use iReady, Measures of Academic Progress (MAP), and common formative assessments to review student learning and plan next steps in PLCs.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

By the end of the 2023-24 school year, 85% of all students will attend school more than 90% of the time.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Combine attendance with Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports committee.
2. Fund student prizes for quarterly drawings.
3. Students receive monthly attendance certificates/pencils for perfect attendance.
4. Messaging to families regarding importance of attendance.





Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard


