## 2023-2024 SCHOOL PERFORMANCE PLAN



### Student Success Goal

Increase Smarter Balanced Assessment proficiency scores by 3-5% in English Language Arts and Math overall and increase English Learner students meeting adequate growth targets on the ACCESS (English Language exam) by 5%.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Review English Language and Math Essential Standards, schoolwide use of Benchmark Curriculum, EnVision, MAP, iReady, formative and summative assessments.
2. Effectively communicate and provide intentional and strategic feedback to students, parents and guardians regarding student progress-via MAP assessment reports, iReady progress, attendance reports, etc.
3. Our English Learner Development facilitator will be on site Monday - Friday (9:00am-11:30am) and will work with all English Learner students, newcomers, and staff during this timeframe.

### Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

Jessie Beck will decrease chronic absenteeism for the 2023-2024 school year to 10% or below from 14% and increase student engagement by 4% from 76% to 80%.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Social and emotional skills across the 5 core competencies will be clearly articulated including developmental benchmarks and indicators.
2. Develop procedures for accurately understanding students' social-emotional functioning and growth throughout the 2023-2024 school year.
3. Regular communication with students, families and teachers regarding behavior.
4. We are setting a tone that the schoolwide expected behaviors will be enforced and rewarded.





Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard




### English / Language Arts
