## Student Success Goal

By the spring 2024 Smarter Balanced Assessment, we will decrease the number of non-proficient students to 50% in English Language Arts (ELA) and to 55% in Math.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will review:

1. Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) ELA for Kindergarten-3<sup>rd</sup> grade, iReady Reading and Math Kinder-5<sup>th</sup> grade.
2. Teacher Frequent Formative Common Assessments, and Walkthrough Data.
3. Teacher Lesson Plans and Big Reports.

## Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

By June 2024, we will continue our Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS), have common expectations, reinforce positive behaviors (teach, model, and reinforce), and work with students and teachers to decrease our minor discipline events to 200 or less and major discipline events from 50 or less.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. School Climate Data (Engagement, Safety, Social and Emotional Competence)
2. Chronic Absenteeism, Attendance monitoring
3. Discipline Data (suspensions, expulsions, average number of instructional days missed), and BIG discipline data.
4. PBIS class point sheet and Class dojo points





Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard




### English / Language Arts
