Student Success Goal

During the 2023-2024 school year, in English Language Arts (ELA) Core Curriculum & Instruction, 3rd – 5th grade students who take the ELA Nevada State Smarter Balanced Assessment will achieve an overall increase in ELA proficiency from 21% to 26% of students above the Meets Standards or Exceeds Standards criteria level score.

Students in grades K-3 will show a 5% increase in ELA proficiency (above 40th percentile) from the 2022-23 school year as measured by ELA Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) RIT score.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will conduct:

1. Professional Development around Science of Reading.
2. Observation of other teachers/grade levels (with ongoing support).
3. Co-teaching with coaches/administrators (with ongoing support).

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

During the 2023-2024 school year absenteeism will decrease in the following categories:

- The total number of students approaching chronic absenteeism (> 5%) will decrease by 5%
- The total number of students experiencing chronic absenteeism (> 10%) will decrease by 3%
- The total number of students experiencing severely chronic absenteeism (> 20%) will decrease by 1%

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Provide opportunities for family voice and engagement.
2. Survey families regarding needs
3. Parent Teacher Organization monthly meetings
4. Provide opportunities for volunteering.
5. Monthly Coffee Conversations with Admin
6. Events dedicated to academics and community building.
7. Daily connections between schools and families





Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard


