2023-2024 SCHOOL PERFORMANCE PLAN



Student Success Goal

By June 2024, Hidden Valley ES will increase overall student performance in English Language Arts and Math by 5 percentage points by the administration of the 2023-2024 Smarter Balanced test. English Language Arts will increase to 58% and Math will increase to 51%.

To support students to achieve this goal:

1. Students will receive login information for Clever.
2. Students complete at least 35-50 minutes per week/subject on personal learning path in iReady. Teachers teach students at each student's instructional level based upon student data.
3. Administration will monitor teacher and student progress through daily walkthroughs providing specific feedback regarding high yield teaching strategies.
4. Grade level Professional Learning Communities meet weekly with administration and coaches to review common assessments and learning path growth and reporting. Teams will determine appropriate interventions for students in need of remediation.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

By June 2024, chronic absenteeism rate will be reduced by 5%, from 22% to 17%. (Our chronic absenteeism percentage prior to COVID).

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. The counselor and secretary will run weekly attendance reports.
2. The counselor and secretary communicate with the office staff to mail attendance letters.
3. Weekly meeting between counselor and principal to analyze attendance reports.
4. Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports school-wide incentive created.





Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard


