Student Success Goal

Incline Elementary School students will show growth in English Language Arts and Mathematics. As a school, we will move from 40% to 45% proficiency by the end of the school year.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Incline Elementary School will use i-Ready instructional tool to help provide individualized instruction to each student.
2. Incline Elementary School will provide STEM based instruction for students.
3. Each grade level team will meet weekly to plan high quality instruction that is engaging for students.


