

Student Success Goal

By June 2024 English Learner (EL) students will increase overall proficiency on Smarter Balance Assessment (SBAC) by 5 percentage points.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Ensure use of Benchmark curriculum during walkthroughs and review of lesson plans.
2. Teachers will receive PD on specific ELLevations strategies to be used each quarter as an extra layer of support with the district's English Language Arts (ELA) curriculum.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

By June of 2024 Echo Loder will see a decrease of 5% in chronic absenteeism and a 2% decrease in severely chronic absenteeism rates.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Administration will run weekly attendance reports.
2. Attendance clerk will make daily calls for those who have unverified absences for the day.
3. Individual classrooms can win prizes when they meet a goal of 15 days with 100% attendance.
4. Use of school-based attendance monitors to track attendance.
5. School will provide resources to help support student attendance.


