Student Success Goal

On English Language Arts (ELA) Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBAC), increase the Student Growth Percentile from 41 to 60 by 2026. Grow ELA SBAC overall proficiency from 21 to 41 by 2026. With annual growth in each measure at 7 percent.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Develop walk-through schedule with area of focus for each week.
2. Revise walk-through form to target non-negotiables.
3. Implement walk-through system that includes a process for teachers to access immediate feedback.
4. Learning Facilitator, and English Learner (EL) Coach to develop system/schedule/structure for providing instructional coaching.
5. Schedule and implement staff instructional rounds/peer walk-throughs.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

Increase percentage of parent participation in the School Climate Survey from 55 to 110 responses. Increase Home visits from 47 to 57 visits during 2023-24 school year.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Provide stronger encouragement to complete the Climate Survey through raffle incentives.
2. Set computers and iPads up in the lobby for parents to complete survey when they visit the school.
3. Provide incentives for parents to attend Parent Teacher Conferences.
4. Provide optional homework opportunities for students.
5. Increase the number of parent engagement academic opportunities and vary the times of day they are offered.





Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard


