## Student Success Goal

By June 2024, Marvin Moss' overall proficiency will increase in the area of English Language Arts, for all third through fifth grade students from 41% to 56%. By June 2024, Marvin Moss students will increase in the area of Math, for all third through fifth grade students from 39% to 50%.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Assessing Comprehension and Communication in English State-to-State (ACCESS) Data for English Learners (EL).
2. i-Ready Diagnostic Assessments.
3. i-Ready Student Data- Educational Pathway.

## Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

By June 2024, Marvin Moss' chronic absenteeism rate will be reduced for our overall student population by 8.2% from 18.2% to 10% as determined schoolwide attendance data. By June 2024, Marvin Moss' Student Climate Survey will increase in the areas of Responsible Decision Making to 65%, Managing of Emotions to 49%, and Management of Goals 65%.

2. Climate Survey Data from students
3. BIG Attendance Reports





Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard


