2023-2024 SCHOOL PERFORMANCE PLAN



Student Success Goal

The goal is to significantly increase reading proficiency scores among Mamie Towles Elementary School students in K-5 grades through the implementation of the i-Ready program. Students' reading i-Ready scores in the "mid or above grade level" and "early on grade level" categories will increase by 10% school wide. Decreasing the number of students who scored two, three or more grade levels below grade level.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will provide:

1. 45 mins per week built into classroom schedules.
2. Professional Learning Communities (PLC) time for teachers, built into the master schedule.
3. Tier I-Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS).
4. Supplemental Tier I with instructional lessons when appropriate.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

Our goal is to increase our connectedness with all families at Mamie Towles through the use of Home Visits. Last year, we reached 33 households with a total of 52 visits. We will increase our households reached from 33 to 37 with a total of 50 home visits schoolwide.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Make appointments with families.
2. Provide additional trainings to train more staff members regarding the Home Visit Program.
3. Plan family educational events (Literacy, Math, Science Nights).
4. Plan family Connectedness Events (Balloon Breakfast, Pumpkin Hallow, Jog-A-Thon).





Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard


