

### Student Success Goal

Using the 2022/2023 Smarter Balanced (SBAC) data as a baseline. Current 5th grade students (2021/22 3rd grade, 2022/2023 4th graders cohort) will grow by 10% in Mathematics over the next year as measured by the cohort's 5th grade SBAC overall Math scores.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Create time for grade levels to meet vertically to discuss and develop a common Math vocabulary and instructional strategies.
2. Provide teachers with training around PLC structures.
3. Create time for quarterly MTSS Meetings.
4. Continuous Feedback.
5. Meet with Families with students with attendance concerns.
6. Aligning grade level PLCs vertically to address Math instructional strategies and vocabulary for students.
7. Identify students that need to move in or out of Tier 1 Instruction through the MTSS Process, quarterly.

### Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

Over the 2023/2024 school year 20% of Westergard students will increase in the areas of self-management of emotions and social awareness as measured by the student climate survey given to Westergard students grades 2-5 twice during the school year.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Staff training on Samford Harmony curriculum starting 10/2023.
2. Follow up coaching with school counselor and administrator around curriculum 2/2023, 3/2023, 4/2023.





Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard




### English / Language Arts
