Student Success Goal

Students below grade level in math will decrease by 5%, as measured by the Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (SBAC).

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Implement the 3 Reads math strategy to improve students' problem-solving and reasoning skills.
2. Ensure students regularly use the new district-adopted program, i-Ready, for at least 40 minutes per week in both math and reading.
3. Provide professional development that focuses on incorporating the four domains of language (listening, speaking, reading, writing) into daily math lessons helping students develop conceptual understanding.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

Increase student self-management of emotions, schoolwork, and goal setting, as measured by our student climate survey.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Deliver guidance lessons that focus on teaching skills that develop self-management of emotions (Zones of Regulation).
2. Provide lesson clarity by sharing lesson objectives before, during, and after each lesson, which allows students to learn with purpose, monitor their learning, and set goals for future learning.
3. Build positive relationships with families through open and regular communication using multiple forms (Class Dojo, email, in-person conference, home visit).





Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard


