Student Success Goal

All departments will work with English Language Development teacher to improve instructional strategies.

All students will be encouraged to attend ACT Boot camp for ACT Test Preparation.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Schedule English Language Development planning time with each department and staff.
2. ACT Scores will be broken down by sub test and disaggregated by sub-populations for targeted teacher data review.
3. ACT Bootcamp will be provided over three days the weekend before the ACT is given through the organization, Tutors Across America.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

By the next climate survey, connection between students, staff and families will all increase by each reporting party at least 2 percentage points. Students 77%-79%, Staff 93%-95%, Families 89%-91%.

2. Teachers in hallways between each class period connecting with students.
3. Plan made with each individual student who is failing at quarter to discuss improvement strategies.








2023 Graduation
