Student Success Goal

North Valleys High School will increase graduation rates from 78% to 82% or greater, through a focus on credit attainment and credit recovery in all grades while working to close the achievement gap in math courses and with our special education population.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Determine what financial resources are available.
2. Identify staff members to teach math support classes.
3. Identify students needing support and schedule them into the appropriate support class.
4. Identify specific students needing support.
5. Work with teachers to develop support math instruction as determined by student need or learning gaps.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

North Valleys High School will help our students feel accepted and connected to school with a more positive sense of self-awareness and self-concept measured by the student climate survey showing a growth from 73%-74%

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Implementation of the four pillars.
2. Continued development of Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) lessons.
3. Direct instruction of SEL lessons, (focus varies per grade level)
4. Lessons to include Digital Citizenship, Habitudes, financial literacy, career building, social awareness, School Connect, Adulting 101
5. Use Microsoft Teams for instructional staff to access SEL lessons.








2023 Graduation
