## 2023-2024 SCHOOL PERFORMANCE PLAN



### Student Success Goal

As measured by the Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBAC), we will increase our overall proficiency levels in Elementary School by 10% in English Language Arts (ELA) and 7% in Math. ELA and Math Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) Subgroups will increase by 5%; ELA and Math Individualized Education Plan (IEP) with increase by 10%; and English Learner (EL) ELA and Math Subgroups will increase by 10%. Overall growth in ELA will improve by 10%.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Identification of as well as Intentional and strategic support of students struggling with ELA Essential Standards.
2. Identify students struggling with ELA curriculum in a more timely and effective process.
3. Identify curriculum resources for interventions.
4. Identify/create tools of measurement to determine proficiency.

### Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

Mount Rose K-8 staff will increase parent's perceptions of their child's learning related behaviors by 5 % and increase Families' perceptions of how well a school matches their child's developmental needs by 10%.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Connect Ed Messages in English and Spanish and continuation of School Facebook page and School Website.
2. The school will communicate with parents in a variety of ways regarding expectations and curriculum.
3. The school will provide parents a variety of opportunities to learn more about the curriculum and ways in which they can support their child's learning at home.





Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard




### English / Language Arts
