

Student Success Goal

Increase proficiency on the state exam, Smarter Balanced (SBAC), in English Language Arts (ELA) by at least 5 percentage points to 17% proficient and Math proficiency by at least 10 percentage points to 18% proficient.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Increase targeted interventions for students behind grade level.
2. Hold regular professional development to support teachers.
3. Use new English/Language Arts, Social Studies, and Science curriculums.
4. Meet weekly to identify students who need more support and create a plan to assist them.
5. Provide regular student rewards for being highly engaged in school.
6. Increase support for chronically absent students.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

Our goal is to increase school communication with families and family attendance at events and parent classes.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Look at parent climate survey results to see where communication needs to be improved the most.
2. Send home a quarterly newsletter and regular Connect Ed emails with school updates.
3. Share more celebrations with families like increases in academic achievement, sports wins, and reductions in behaviors.
4. Host three Parent University classes and multiple family nights during the year.





Percent Achieving 'At or Above' Standard


